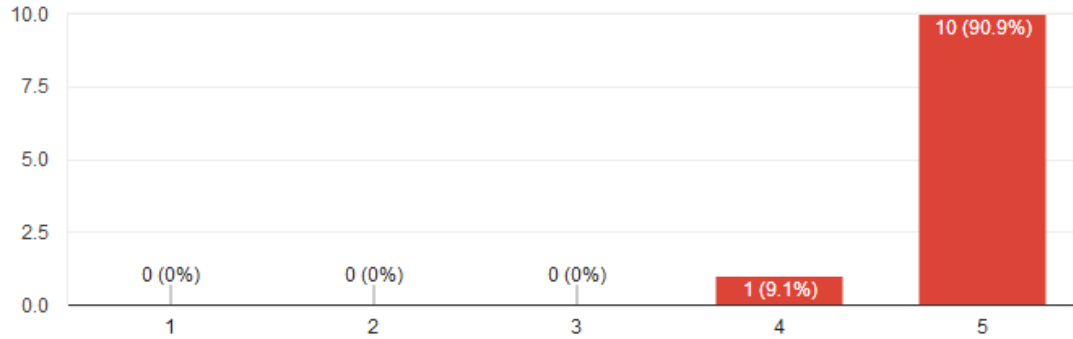


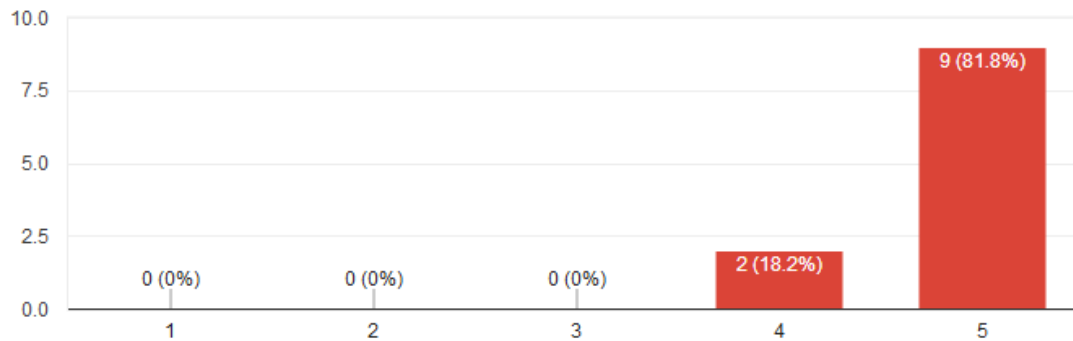
Please rate your satisfaction with the performance venue.

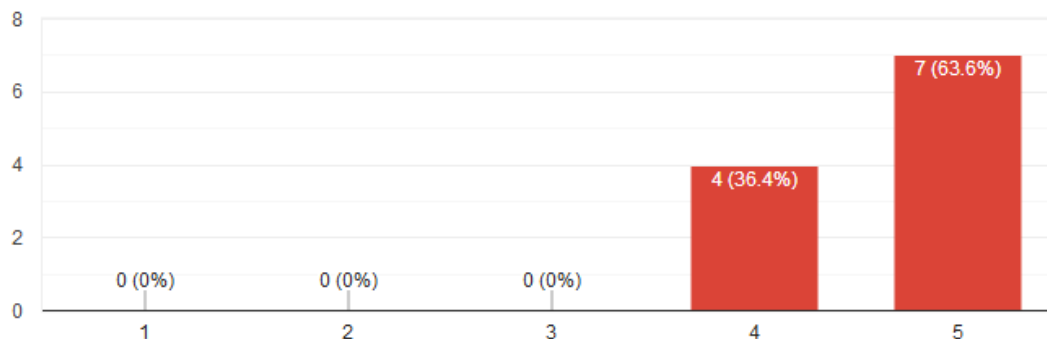
Please rate your satisfaction with the experience of singing with a semi-professional orchestra.

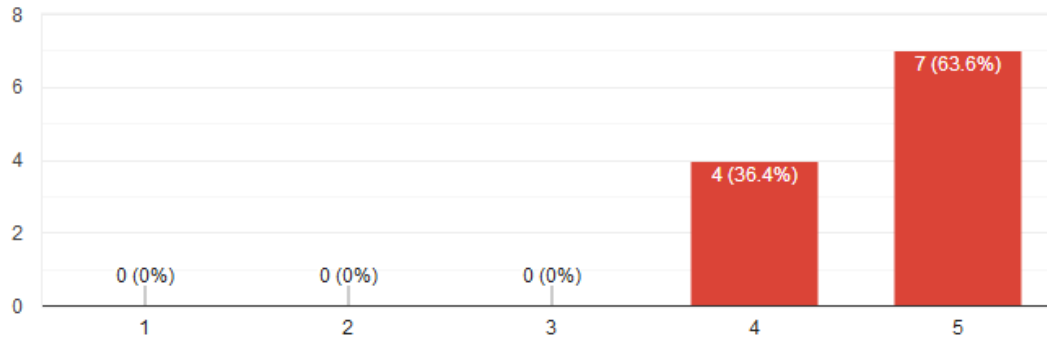
Please rate your satisfaction with performing as part of a mass choir with other choral ensembles.
